






The site located north of the city centre and the College of Art and between University sites.

- £15.8 million from Heritage Lottery Fund
- £8 million from Plymouth City Council
- £4.2 million from Arts Council England
- £2 million from Coastal Communities
- £250,000 from Garfield Weston Foundation
- £150,000 from University of Plymouth
- £128,000 from Wolfson Foundation
- £300,000 from a private gift

REVENUE

- Ongoing from Plymouth City Council
- National Portfolio Funding from ACE secured for 2018-2022 of £4.2 million
- Mayflower 400 and Arts Council £375,000 for Mayflower projects



- R&D for contemporary art programme










A sculptured life size mammoth, created using 3D Printing.

ALBUM AND MEMORY BOX






A changing display of images and objects, designed to provoke personal and local memories.

stands at 4.5m tall.






Mass display cases containing 350 items of the city's collection of decorative art. Analysis of the city's art collections.
