The May flower's journey started with a group of religious Separatists based in the north of England, who we now call the Pilgrims. Regarded as renegades who rejected fundamental principles of the State and Church of England, they worshipped in secret to avoid arrest and persecution.

The Pilgrims commissioned two ships to transport them to the 'New World' in America, the May flower and Speedwell. They met in Southampton, from where they planned to sail directly to America. However, problems with the Speedwell meant they needed to stop to undertake repairs, first in Dartmouth and then again in Plymouth.

The Speedwell was eventually declared unfit for the journey. The Mayflower left on 16 September 1620*, with around 30 crew and 102 passengers were Separatists, some economic migrants and some were

Tour Highlights:

- Visit the villages and churches of Scrooby, Babworth & Austerfield that were home to radical Puritan congregations and where Bradford and Brewster shaped their beliefs
- Explore Gainsborough Old Hall, one of the best preserved medieval manor houses in England
- Walk the cobbled streets of historic Lincoln, see King John's 1215 Magna Carts whose influence is seen in the Mayflower Compact and the American BIT of Rights
- Visit Boston Guildhall and the cells where the fleeing Pligrims were held
- Visit immingham from where the Separatists escaped to Holland
- · Travel to Leiden, Holland where the Separatists spent many years . Go in search of Pilorim Edward Winslow in Worcester & Drollwich Son
- . Explore the Port of Harwich where the Mayflower ship was built and her
- Mester Christopher Jones Ilved
- Follow the journey of the ship to her home port in London and explore: Explore the port city of Southempton where the Mayflower and Speedwell
- ships prepared for voyage
- Visit Dartmouth where the Mayflower and Speedwell ships stayed whilst undergoing repairs
- . Stand on the Mayflower Steps in Plymouth, the city from where the Mayflower ship and her passengers finally departed on 16 September 1620.


