

#### Nuclear South West is the nuclear cluster for the South West of England.

The South West is set to become a nuclear hub in the next two decades, with 15 projects worth £50 billion to our economy. Hinkley Point C (HPC) will be the first new nuclear power station in the UK for a generation, capable of generating 7% of the UK's total energy requirement. Over 60% of the project's £20billion construction value is predicted to go to UK companies. The project will create 25,000 job opportunities, 1,000 apprenticeships and will pump £100m/year in to the regional economy. 

#### A recent study by CareersBox has ranked Plymouth and the South West as one of the top cities and regions in Great Britain for marine opportunities

Plymouth is the number one hotspot for marine job openings 2016-2021 with 311 job openings, followed by Inner London West with 264 job openings. The South West is the number one region for marine jobs in 2016 with 4,066 jobs, followed by the South East with 3,735 jobs. It is also ranked number one for projected number of openings in marine occupations 2016-2021 with a projected 840 openings, followed by the South East with 673.
