

NORTH CROSS AND PLYMOUTH RAILWAY STATION —

Overview of site: The railway station is located on the northern edge of the city centre close to Plymouth University, as well as a a recently opened multi-million pound coach hub.

Site area: 1.86 hectares / 4.6 acres (whole site area, including existing station buildings).

Status: The redevelopment of the railway station is supported by Proposal CC14 (North Cross and the Railway Station) of the City Centre and University Area Action Plan 2006 - 2021 (adopted April 2010). Identified as a key strategic site in the City Centre Masterplan which was consulted upon in summer 2016 alongside the Local Plan consultation. Potential: All or part of the land is available for redevelopment, subject to approval of the relevant interested parties/land owners – Network Rail, Great Western Railway and Plymouth City Council.
